

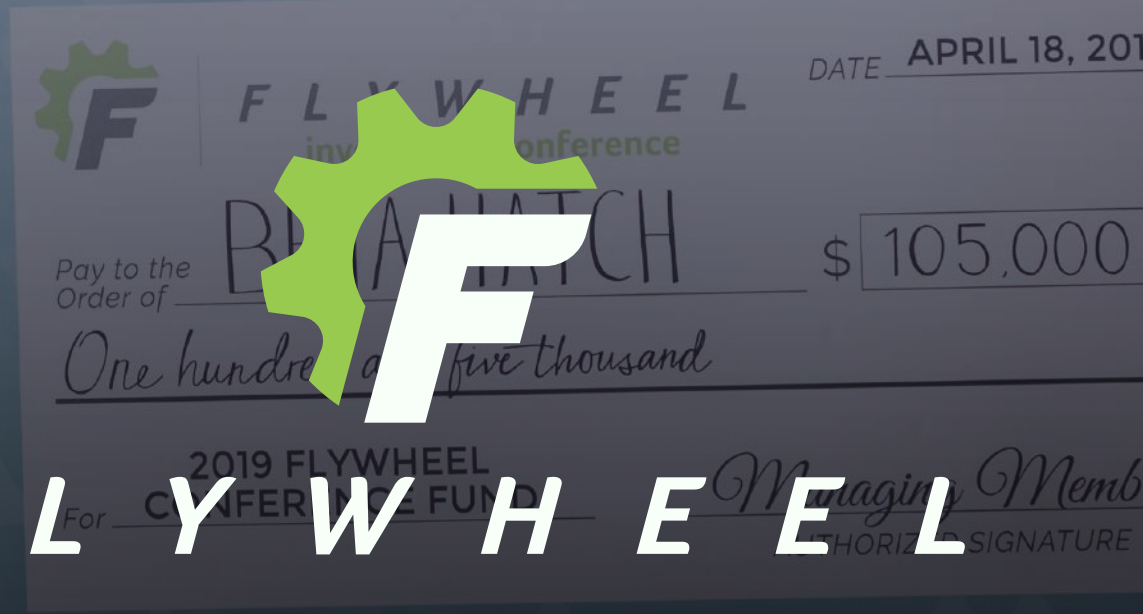

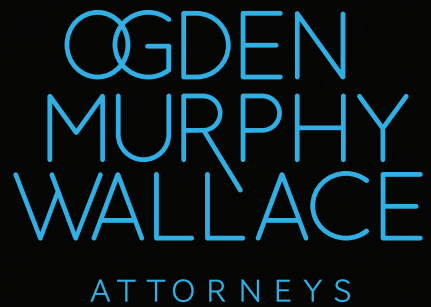

Parrots is an intuitive robotics company that develops a socially assistive companion for people with mobility and communication challenges. The robots are built to be their friendly companions on their shoulders like real-life parrots. The socially assistive robots are plug-and-play devices, which can be controlled hands-free through eye-tracking or other abilities switches. Parrots create four values (4 C's): Communication, Control, Connectivity, and Compatibility.

1. **Communication:** AI/ML smart communication with intuitive prediction system, which is 4x faster than all current assistive apps and augmentative and alternative communication devices. The system can speak and interact automatically or manually based on the surrounding context and users' behaviors.
2. **Control:** with a 360-degree camera to navigate and safe control of the wheelchair with panoramic computer vision in real-time, and broaden a user's field of view and identifies objects that are either dangerous or that might be of interest to the user.
3. **Connectivity:** with smart home devices. Also, the robots are built on understanding the sound and visuals in their surroundings and taking actions based on the environment.
4. **Compatibility:** with all existing assistive switches, including eye-tracking, head mouse, joystick, or facial expression.

Golden Sherpa offers facilities a real-time inventory tool directly reaching people in search of available placement, allowing for a timely, cost-efficient process for filling empty beds.

Golden Sherpa’s community subscriber model disrupts the senior living referral industry by creating a marketplace for consumers and senior living communities to share information and connect in real-time. Sixty million baby boomers will turn 65 in 10 years, impacting families and seniors across the county. Their families will be asked to make monumental decisions about their loved one’s placement in senior care. Golden Sherpa provides detailed community information, a consumer portal to connect directly to communities, a tool to schedule a phone call, a virtual, or in-person tour saving much needed time for the families and providers. Providers receive direct, actionable referrals minus high commission fees. Golden Sherpa reduces the stress, anxiety, and frustration involved in filling available placement in senior living for both the consumer and senior living provider.

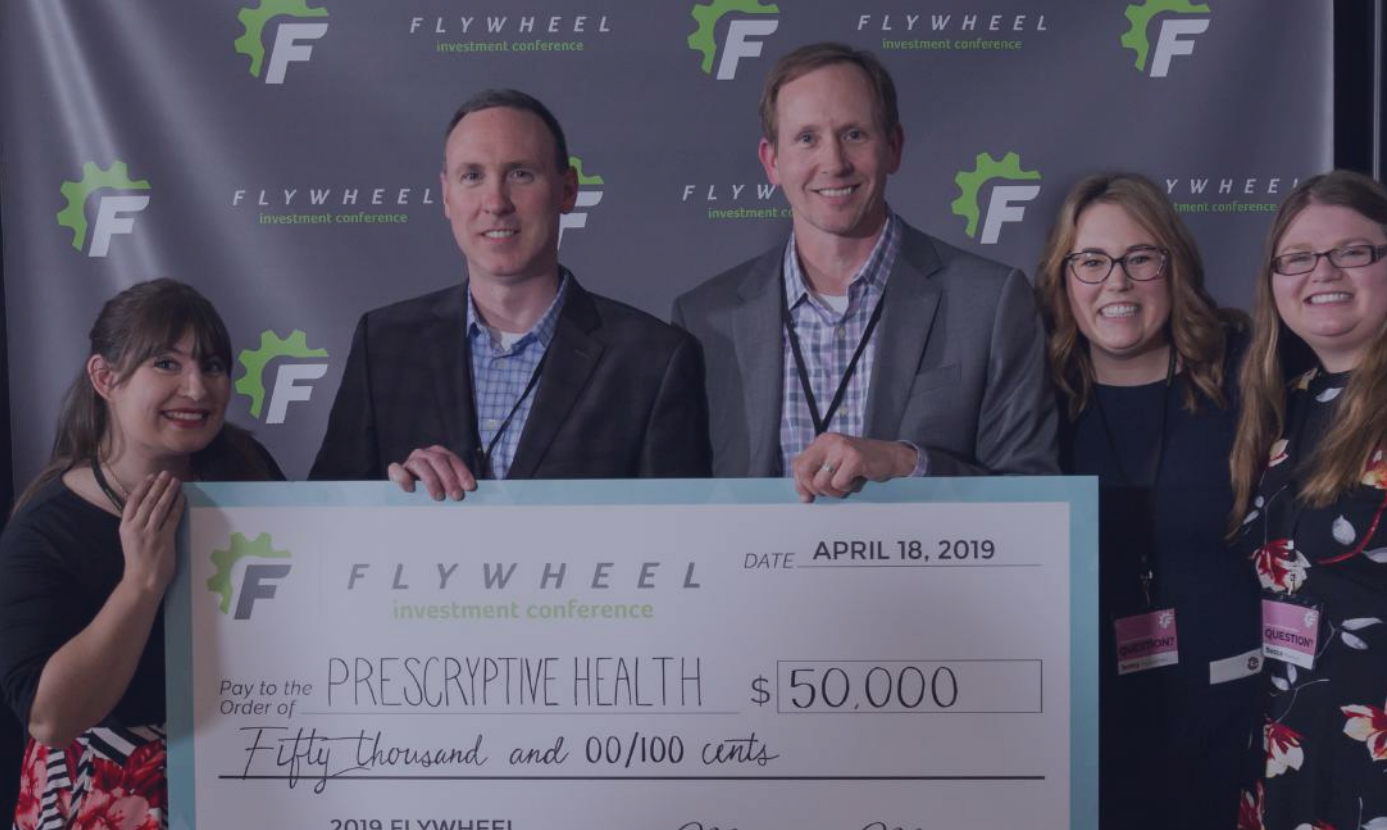
